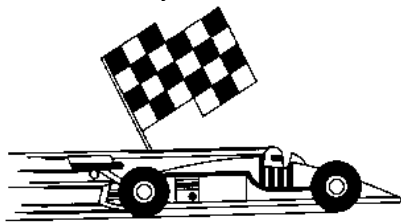

Pinewood Derby Weigh-In

The **MANDATORY** Weigh-in is Friday, February 19th at the Olmsted Falls High School cafeteria from 5-7 p.m. You may have to adjust the weight of your car, so please plan to arrive early and to allow yourself time. Please note that cars will be impounded after the weigh-in. **If you don't weigh-in on Friday, you MAY NOT race on Saturday.**

Pinewood Lubrication

Under BSA rules, boys may use dry powdered Axle Lube (BSA Item #17106) or Graphite (BSA Item #17019) ONLY. They may not use any other lubricant, especially oils and silicone sprays.

Pinewood Adults'/Siblings' Race

We will have an unlimited class adults' race on the night of setup; siblings are welcome to participate. There is a \$5.00 registration fee. The Pack will

keep 50% of the entrance fees, and the top three winners will split the other 50% as follows: 1st place – 25%, 2nd place =15%, and 3rd place – 10%. Sign up tonight or contact Seth Tomasch if interested. You may purchase a car from him for \$4.00. Adult Race entrants must use BSA wheels and axles. The car must not exceed 7" in length or 5 oz in weight, be able to race on the track, and have "102" somewhere on it. **ALL MODIFICATIONS TO BODY, WHEELS, and AXLES ARE LEGAL!** Please have your car weighed-in between 5-7 p.m. Race will begin shortly after 7 p.m.
