Scouting 360

Greater Cleveland Council BSA is hosting Scouting 360 this year, an event SO ENORMOUS, SO HUGE, that it occurs only every three years! All Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Venturing Groups are invited. The event will be held May 4-6, 2007 at the Cuyahoga County Fairgrounds. Included are over 100 programs and activities: Climbing wall, archery, rocketry, Revolutionary and Civil War re-enactments, fireworks, helicopter tours, Battle of the Bands, Council Pinewood Derby Finals, and a huge Grandstand show to name only a few.

Cub Scout activities are on Saturday. Only registered Cub Scouts and leaders may participate in the Activities. FULL UNIFORM REQUIRED. A BSA Class 1 Health Form is required for any attendee. Check-in will be 8:00 AM- 4:30 PM on Saturday, May 5. Pack 102 Scouts who meet the rechartering deadline will receive FREE ADMISSION; otherwise it is \$10 per Cub Scout (\$15 if you are camping). Families may attend at a cost of \$5.00 per person (free for those under age 5). Families may visit the Midway, attend the religious services, visit the static displays and attend the Grandstand show and Fireworks.

Camping will be available to both families and Webelos. Webelos may

camp with a Boy Scout Troop; see your Den Leader for more information. Families may use RVs, campers, or tents. Cost is \$3.00 for one night or \$5.00 for both. All cooking is above ground, no fire pits.
