### October Pack Meeting/Cake Auction

The annual cake auction will occur at the October Pack meeting. It is a fun evening for Scouts and their parents! Each Scout works with his parent/adult partner to bake and decorate a cake. The cake may be any flavor, shape, or design; the more creative, the better! You may view pictures of cakes entered in prior years on our website. Place your cake on cardboard or a disposable tray and attach an index card listing the Scout's name, his rank, (e.g., Tiger), cake flavor, and frosting flavor. Arrive no later than 6:45 to register the cake. Scouts bid on cakes of their choice. Every boy that brings a

cake buys a cake (one per Scout). Be sure to discuss with your Scout in advance how much he is allowed to bid! In past years, the average selling price has been about \$30, but winning bids have ranged from \$5 to over \$100! Prior to the auction, boys will vote on the Most Awesome cake for each rank, and prizes will be given to the winners.

**Please Note:** We do not ask our scouts to sell popcorn. The cake auction and Santa's Secret Shop are our only fundraisers. They allow the Pack to provide awards, Pinewood Derby cars, books, neckerchiefs, and food for Pack events including the Blue & Gold dinner and summer campout. Please be generous with your Scout's spending limit! Thank you.
